



## **Airstrip Information**

- Approximately 800m of graded gravel/clay.
- Latitude; 22.9670, longitude; 116.9826 or UTM 7460124N, 498244E, elevation 900ft
- Please call on UHF 36 before landing
- Disregard location of Cheela Plains Outcamp on WAC chart, as this is the original camp no longer in use located at the Cheela Spring.
- Near East-West in orientation with clear ground either end, visibly marked with 6m white PVC at end corners. There is a low fence at the Western end extremity and the campground/amenities at the North edge of the Eastern end. There is ample clear parking at the Eastern end.
- The Google Map shows a "kink" in the airstrip, but it has been straightened and lengthened since then.
- The accommodation Facilities are located approximately 100m from the airstrip.

## **Accommodation Options**

- 4 Queen Ensuites in Plainsview Lodge.
- 3 Family room Ensuite family rooms with a queen bed, a single and a trundle bed.
- 4 Double rooms with a double bed.
- 20 single rooms with a King Single bed in each room.
- Powered and unpowered sites at the Red Plains Campground.
- Station tents at the Emu Campground.

## **Accommodation Inclusions**

- Linen and towels are provided.
- Shared amenities and dining area.
- All rooms are air conditioned and have a small fridge.
- Free us of washing machines for accommodation guests.

## **Additional Considerations**

- A two-course set menu or Wednesday's campfire burgers are available by prearrangement.
- Barista coffee, sweet treats & snacks available between 7:30am 2:30pm every day.
- 4x4 Gorge safari self-drive which is 30km from station stay offers a fantastic opportunity to connect with the Epic Pilbara landscape while learning about the cattle station and the unique geology of the area.
